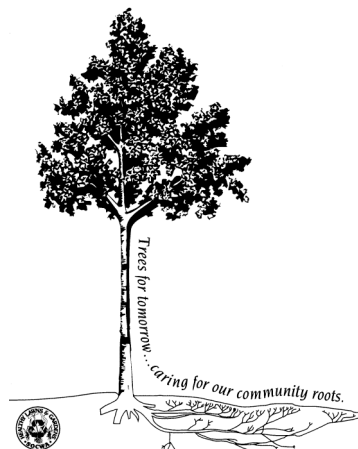


# TREES FOR TOMORROW
